- **End of Support:**

Microsoft will officially end support for Windows 10 on October 14, 2025.

- **No More Updates:**

After this date, you won't receive security patches, bug fixes, or other updates from Microsoft.

- **Increased Security Risks:**

Without regular updates, your Windows 10 PC will be more susceptible to malware, viruses, and other security threats.

- **Potential for Problems:**

Hardware and software that rely on Windows 10 updates might stop working correctly or become incompatible.

- **Microsoft's Recommendation:**

Microsoft strongly recommends upgrading to Windows 11 to ensure continued security and access to the latest features.

- **Extended Security Updates (ESU):**

Microsoft will offer an Extended Security Updates (ESU) program for users who want to keep using their Windows 10 PCs after support ends, but this will require a paid subscription which doubles each year for a maximum of three years. [Read more on the ESU Program](#)
